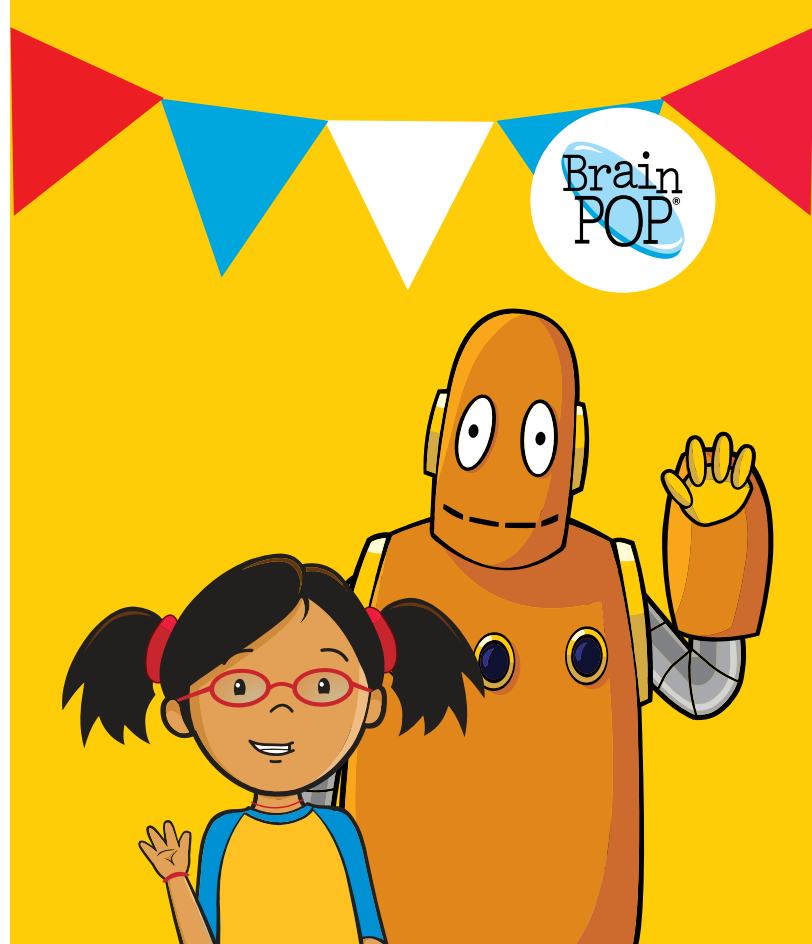

## BRAINPOP JR. AT HOME

If you have a school-wide subscription, help extend learning at home. Plus, our activities are fun for the whole family! The following valuable tips will aid in enhancing your students' BrainPOP Jr. experience.

**Lesson Ideas** Each BrainPOP Jr. topic includes suggestions for fun family activities. Click the Lesson Ideas button for extensive background information and home activities.

**Pause Points** Annie's questions make great discussion prompts: pause the movie every time she asks one, then invite students to share what they know about the topic at hand.

**Read All About It** The Read About It feature on each BrainPOP Jr. topic page includes recommended picture books related to each topic. The books are a great springboard for family reading time.

**Match-Up** Encourage students to utilize the Word Wall feature associated with each movie topic to review vocabulary at home. Make a matching game out of the topic related words by writing the words and definitions on separate note cards. Then, with a family member, take turns flipping over pairs of cards to match vocabulary words with their definitions.

**Game Show** Each BrainPOP Jr. movie includes an easy and hard quiz. Parents can turn taking a quiz into a family game show by having "contestants" press a buzzer or ring a bell as they race to share answers.

**Laugh Out Loud** Go Belly Up over your BrainPOP Jr. topic by reading the associated Belly Up comic and Pop A Joke. Encourage students to create their own comic or joke based on the daily BrainPOP Jr. topic.
