

Pacing Guide and Supporting Activities: Setting Goals and Taking Action

Grade Band: Grade 6-8 | Duration: 5 Days

Overview: Students first explore BrainPOP's Setting Goals topic, which explains why we set goals and details the SMART technique: specific; measurable; attainable; realistic or relevant; and time-bound. Then, students discover how Malala (or another <u>biography</u> that aligns to their interest or the curriculum) applied goal-setting strategies to reach her goals and make changes.

Unit Goal: Students will set a grade-level goal for the new school year using the concept mapping tool, Make-a-Map, and identify actions required to achieve that goal.

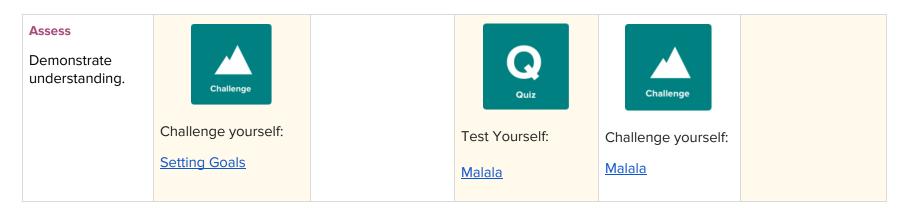

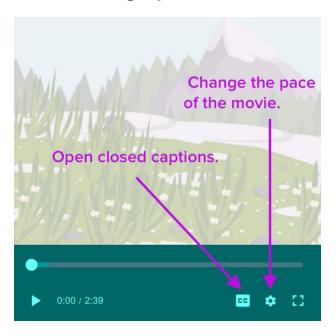
