

A picture can say a lot. But we have solid data as back-up, too! Scientists check the quality of the air using a measure called an *index*. The Air Quality Index should be under 100. When the plant reopened, the index went from good to unhealthy almost at once. It has just gotten worse.



This unhealthy air is causing more and more **respiratory** problems. Patients with asthma wear masks whenever they go outside. Other conditions, such as **chronic obstructive pulmonary disease**, are not only on the rise, they are worsening. In recent interviews, members of the community were very vocal about their suffering, but one person's cry stood out from all the rest. **Resident Luz Toro shared, "Seeing how badly the fumes have affected my COPD, I doubt I'll make it to my grandson's third birthday."**



Script for Austen's Video



We now know that air **pollution** from the plant has caused the rise in these illnesses. And they're still on the rise. The plant keeps spreading its poisons into the sky.







The very young and old are most at risk from breathing polluted air. Others should note any changes in their health. A harsh cough can be a sign to see a doctor.





The Air Quality Index, or AQI, should be under 100. If the AQI gets past 150, the air is unhealthy for everyone in the community. As you can see from the graph, when the plant reopened, the AQI went from normal to unhealthy almost at once, and the situation has gotten worse.



The data proves that something needs to be done about the power plant immediately, before more people suffer. Respiratory complaints at our clinic have more than doubled since the power plant reopened. People with asthma are wearing masks whenever they go outside. Other conditions, such as chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, are not only on the rise, they are worsening. 
